This DART Rider e-mail notice is sent to you as part of our continuing efforts to keep you aware of the services and programs we offer, and news, including service changes, rider alerts, and system improvements.

Newark Transit Hub Construction - On Monday, March 24, 2008, construction begins on a new transit hub on Farmer Lane in the City of Newark. The community can anticipate a new transfer point for public buses with a passenger shelter, pedestrian sidewalks, bike path, landscaping, and a new road – Pomeroy Lane. The \$1.2 million project will coincide with DART's service change that will occur this summer. Upon completion, six DART bus routes, including the Rt 31 Newark Trolley, will serve the hub. Most of the construction should be completed by early July, and completely finished by the fall.

This year's theme for DART's Annual Transit Poster Contest is "Its Easy Being Green while riding DART." Students are asked to create an artistic poster illustrating how public transit adds to a greener Delaware. The entry deadline is March 31, 2008. Children in grades 6 through 12 are eligible to participate.
