SEPTA R2 Service Change Notice – A SEPTA R2 Service Change and a new weekday schedule in Delaware starts on July 26, 2010. Primary changes include: Train #272 (formerly Train #4672) departs Philadelphia and all stops 4 minutes later. Train #1207 (formerly Train #7207) does not layover in Wilmington so train arrives at Churchmans Crossing and Newark 9 minutes earlier. Please note that train numbers may have changed. High Water Alert for Claymont Station – There is currently high water in the underpass at Claymont Station. Although Claymont Station is open, DART recommends that passengers use either the Wilmington or Marcus Hook Stations. This event will mostly will affect northbound traffic.
