This DART Rider e-mail notice is sent to you as part of our continuing effort to keep you aware of the services and programs we offer, and news, including service changes, rider alerts, and system improvements.

ATTENTION SEPTA WILMINGTON/NEWARK LINE RIDERS – Temporary schedule adjustments on August 14 & 15, August 21 & 22, and September 11 & 12, 2010 due to stone wall replacement work will change weekend train service between 5:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. Train #9201 will run 12 minutes earlier from Temple University. Train #9203 will run 9 minutes earlier from Temple University. Between 7:01 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. all Wilmington/Newark Line service will operate as regularly scheduled. From 9:01 p.m. until the end of service, Train #232 will run 10 minutes later from Marcus Hook. Train #235 will run 8 minutes later from Temple University. Train #9236 will run 6 minutes later from Marcus Hook. All trains affected operate only on Saturday, except Train #232 which runs on Saturday & Sunday. For more information, visit [SEPTA Alert](#).

Track 1 at the Wilmington Train Station will be out of service on Wednesday, August 11, 2010 from 7 AM to 3:30 PM at the Wilmington Station. Riders are advised to listen to station announcements for boarding locations of SEPTA trains during the outage.
