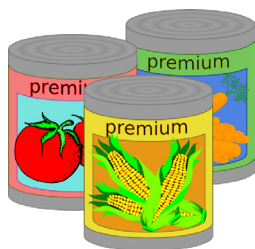
Please help DART and the Food Bank feed more hungry Delawareans by bringing nonperishable items to "Stuff The Bus".
