## HOW TO USE THIS SCHEDULE STEP-BY-STEP

If you need help reading the schedule or riding the bus, please call 1-800-652-3278.

1. On the center pages of this brochure find the bus route map. The DART Connect and Flex Route 903 maps are near the back of this brochure.
2. Look at the map and see if there is a bus stop near you. Do this for both the starting point of your trip and the ending point of your trip.

**Note:** Major timepoints are shown on the route maps.

All bus stops are listed on the schedules for Routes 201, 204, 206, 212, 215, and the Flex Route.

Visit [DartFirstState.com](http://DartFirstState.com) to view all bus stops.

3. When you have found the bus stops that are closest to where you live and where you are going, determine which route serves those stops. The route number is found along the line on the map where your stops are located. If the stops are located on two different routes, you will have to board the second route at a common bus stop location or at the Georgetown Transit Hub.
4. For the Flex Route, Flag Zones have been established in designated areas allowing you to “flag” or wave down the bus. The driver will determine the safest stop location within the approved zone. You can verbally request a Flag Zone drop off while on the bus, and it’s helpful to use a landmark description.
5. Find the bus route schedule you will be using. First, check the arrival times for your destination, to make sure you catch a bus that will get you where you are going by the time you need to be there. Then, read UP that same column until you reach the bus stop from which you will be leaving. If it is not a major timepoint listed in bold, you must estimate time of bus arrival.

Follow these same instructions to plan your return trip.

For the Flex Route, bus arrival times are shown in minutes past the hour (:00).

## COMO USAR EL HORARIO DE LOS AUTOBÚS - PASO A PASO

1. En las páginas centrales de este follete encontrará el mapa de la ruta del autobús. Los mapas de DART Connect y Ruta Flex 903 se encuentran cerca de la parte posterior de este follete.
2. Mire el mapa y encuentre la parada más cerca de usted. Haga esto para empezar y terminar su viaje.

**Nota:** Las paradas principales se muestran en el mapa de la ruta. Todas las paradas del autobús se encuentran en las listas de los horarios de las rutas 201, 204, 206, 212, 215, y las Ruta Flex. Visite [DartFirstState.com](http://DartFirstState.com) para ver todas las paradas.

3. Cuando usted encuentra la parada de autobús más cerca a donde vive y adonde va determine que ruta sirve estas paradas. El número de la ruta se encuentra a lo largo de la línea del mapa donde se encuentran las paradas. Si las paradas se hallan en dos rutas diferentes usted tiene que coger la segunda ruta en la parada de Georgetown.
4. En las Ruta Flex, hay Zonas “Flag” designadas como áreas donde usted puede parar el autobús con la mano. El conductor decidirá el lugar más seguro para detenerse dentro de la zona aprobada. Usted también puede pedir verbalmente bajarse del autobús dentro de estas zonas designadas, para lo cual es útil describir un punto de referencia.
5. Encuentre la ruta de autobús que va a usar. Encuentre la hora de llegar a su destino para estar seguro de que puede coger el autobús que lo llevará a su destino a la hora que usted tiene que estar allí.  
Ahora lea para arriba en la misma columna de tiempo hasta que llegue al tiempo que está en la misma fila del sitio adonde va salir. Si no hay mayores tiempo que estan escritos, necesita que calcular el tiempo de la autobús. Siga las mismas instrucciones para su regreso.

## BUS STOPS



Bus stops have been located in most heavily traveled areas of the county. When waiting for the bus, make sure you are standing under the sign so the driver knows to pull over for you.

## FLAG ZONES



For the Flex Route 903, Flag Zones have been established in designated areas allowing customers to “flag” or wave down the bus. The driver will determine the safest stop location within the approved zone. A Flag Zone drop off is verbally requested while the customer is on the bus, and using a landmark description is helpful.

## GUIDELINES / HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

No eating, drinking, smoking or playing of any audio/video device (unless earphones or earbuds are being used) is permitted within the bus. Please be courteous when using cell phones - no speakerphones allowed.

Please make the front side and two front facing bench seats closest to the driver available to disabled and elderly passengers.



All vehicles are equipped with wheelchair lifts.



All vehicles have bike racks. Passengers are responsible for securing bicycles.

DART First State is not responsible for items left on the bus. Suspicious items are subject to immediate disposal. For Lost & Found items, call (302) 760-2800.

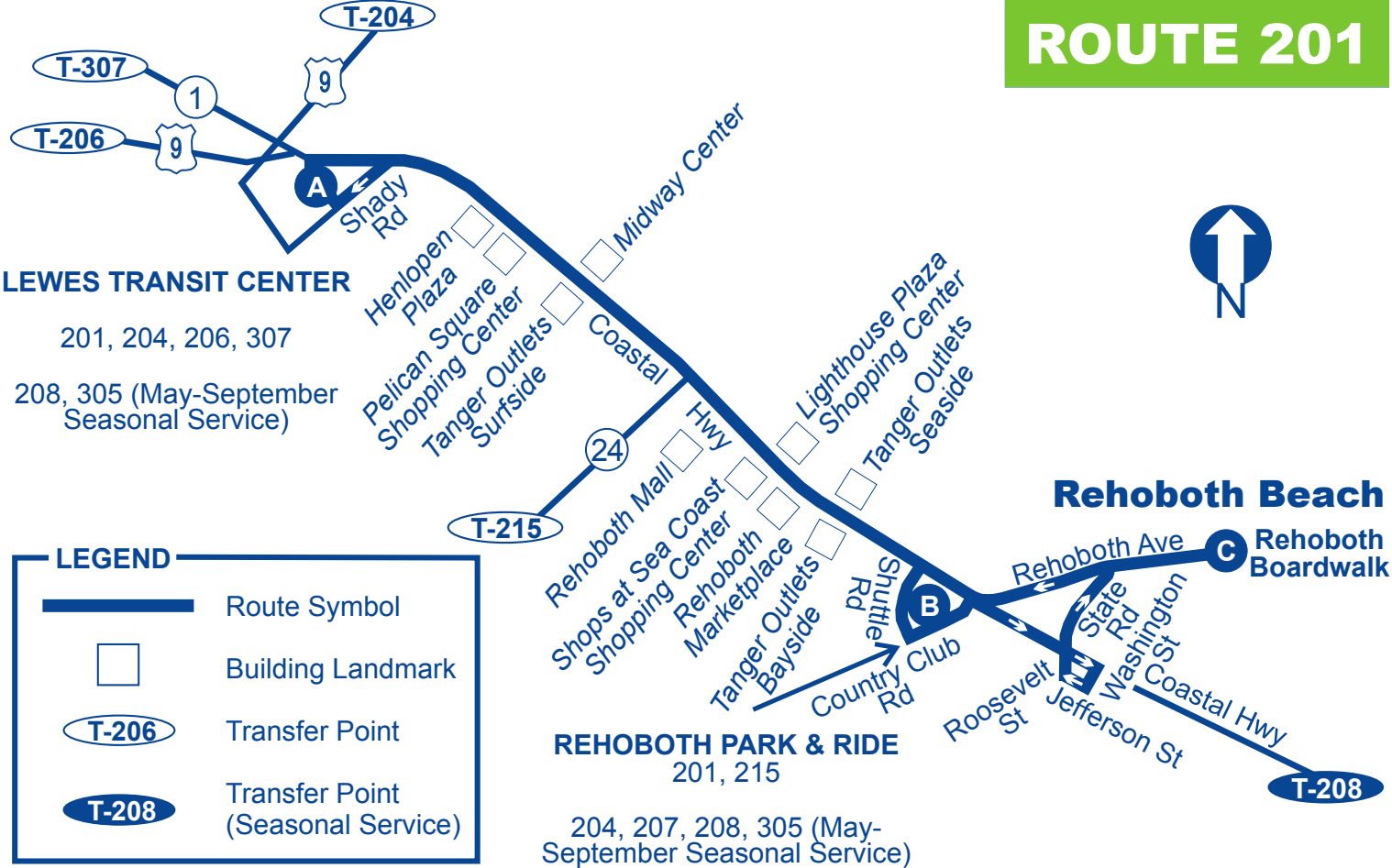

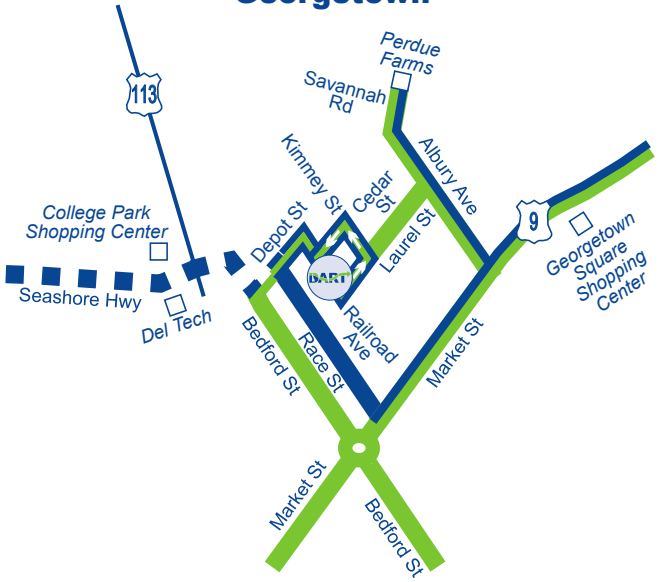
