Elderly Disabled Transit Advisory Committee

DART is inviting transportation advocates for seniors and persons with disabilities to become a member of an important committee. DART staff fully supports the work of EDTAC at their regularly scheduled meetings; where riders, advocates, and representatives from agencies work together to improve service for the aging and disability communities.

EDTAC meets to discuss and advise DART on topics impacting seniors and individuals with disabilities utilizing DART Paratransit and Fixed Route Bus services. Discussions include: On-time performance, route changes, accessibility, travel training, communication with riders, eligibility, reservations, and training as well as fiscal updates received from the Delaware Transit Corporation.

Steps to be considered for EDTAC membership:

1. Attend at least one meeting prior to submitting a request to be considered for membership.*
2. Submit a letter of interest and your reasons for wanting to join EDTAC, including a brief resume of your experience, to: Belinda Strickland, ADA Compliance Specialist, Belinda.Strickland@delaware.gov or by calling (302) 760-2827.
3. DART will share your request with all EDTAC members prior to the next meeting.
4. Prospective candidates will be invited to the next EDTAC meeting to participate in a brief question and answer session prior to a committee vote.

Paratransit or Fixed Route Services to and from scheduled EDTAC meetings may be offered free of charge for eligible candidates.
